- Opportunities to share their cultural heritage with others and to gain an understanding of individual cultural, religious, and racial differences.

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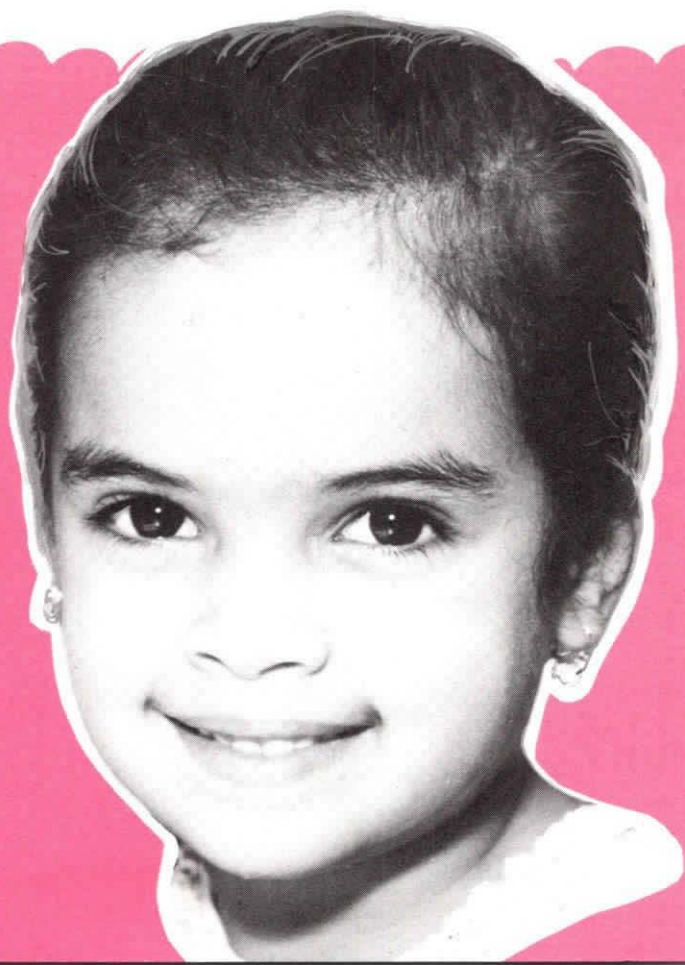
