

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
TO THE
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE ALLIANCE FOR VOLUNTEERISM, INC.

To: The Recorder of Deeds, D.C.
Washington, D.C.

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 29, Chapter 10 of the Code of Laws of the District of Columbia, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is The Alliance For Volunteerism, Inc.

SECOND: The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the Directors of the corporation on June 15, 1976, in the manner prescribed by the Code of Laws of the District of Columbia,

Article THIRD of the Articles of Incorporation was deleted and, in its place, the following new Article THIRD was adopted:

"THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, or any of them, to wit, to be operated exclusively for the benefit of, to perform the functions of, and/or to carry on the business of nonprofit organizations (a)(i) which have established a tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, and are not private foundations by reason of their exclusion under Section 509(a)(1) and Section 509(a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or (ii) which have established a tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, and which would be described in Section 509(a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, if they were organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, and (b) which are engaged in the encouragement and support of volunteers and volunteerism, and, in furtherance of such purposes, to receive contributions of money, assistance, property (whether real, personal, or mixed) or any interest therein, or any other manner of contributions to be used in furtherance of the objectives and purposes of the corporation, and in general, to carry on any other activities connected with or incidental to the

objects and purposes of the corporation and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of the District of Columbia upon corporation formed under the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporation Act."
